A Juneau County Retail Food Establishment – Serving Meals license is required if you prepare, sell, or serve food to the public. Continental Breakfasts are Retail Food Establishments – Serving meals. Bulk milk containers are allowable under the pre-packaged license. In accordance with Juneau County Ordinance Chapter 6 Businesses and Business Regulations, I do hereby make application to the Juneau County Health Department for an operating permit for the license year July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025.

Inspection and licensing services are being provided by the Wood County Health Department.

Operating in any part of the fiscal year requires a permit.

How to Determine Retail Food Establishment – Serving Meals: License Complexity Category

Check all statements that apply

Retail food establishments - serving meals are placed into four categories based on food safety risks. A retail food establishment serving meals that are prepackaged and TCS only prepares individually wrapped, single food servings, which are packaged off-premises by a licensed processor, with the on premise activity limited to heating and serving. EXAMPLE – whole frozen pizzas.

The other three categories (simple, moderate, and complex) use a point system to determine the license complexity category. Use the checklist below to calculate your license complexity category.

- ___ Establishment has a self-service salad bar or food bar. Does not include condiments, bakery or toppings. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment processes fresh or frozen raw poultry, meat, seafood, or eggs. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment operates using a variance or HACCP plan. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment operates using a Bare Hand Contact or Time as a Public Health Control Plan. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment offers catering or preordered meals in bulk quantity for events. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment cold holds, hot holds, or reheats time/temperature control for safety (TCS) foods. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment does cooling of cooked or reheated time/temperature control for safety (TCS) foods. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment wholesales foods that requires refrigeration. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment chops, dices, mixes, slices, blanches, boils, cooks, packages, or assembles product. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment has an additional area(s), other than the main kitchen, where food preparation activities occur. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment prepares food specifically for a highly susceptible population, such as a nursing home or day care. (1 point)
- ___ Establishment has a customer seating capacity greater than 75, or has a drive-thru window. (1 point)

***NOTE:** A facility that has been ordered closed, or been linked statistically to a food borne illness, is immediately placed in the COMPLEX category for the current and following license year.
