Wood County Communications Department Activity Report December 2024

- 1. Visited every tower and radio installation location to inventory and document serial numbers of our net clocks, in order to obtain replacement memory cards and updated firmware.
- 2. Met with a vendor to learn more about technical parameters of different radio products. Ordered several control stations including one to be used by Dispatch for the Marshfield PD channel and another for the Wisconsin Rapids PD channel and paid for using ARPA funds.
- 3. Worked with a tower crew to do further testing at the 6 tower sites that had antennas that didn't pass previous testing to determine the cause of the failure, and what parts were needed for repairs. Researched and ordered those parts.
- 4. Answered some questions from the Highway Department regarding some radio equipment they use. Obtained a quote and placed an order to take advantage of a year-end pricing special.
- 5. Corresponded with an equipment vendor to gather technical information regarding how to connect the console used in Dispatch to the updated simulcast radio system equipment using a new digital connection called DFSI.
- 6. Worked with the County Clerk to answer a contractor's questions regarding licensing and payroll withholding requirements to do work in the County.
- 7. Attended several radio system planning meetings and the Public Safety Committee meeting.

Remarks:

Sadly, December was our busiest month of 2024. 2024 was also our busiest year, sans 2022 (Covid) that I have reports for. When I deduct the Covid related deaths in 2022 (while tragic, I believe the deaths due to Covid are an anomaly) 2024 was our busiest year with the overall numbers of deaths in Wood County, the number of death certificates our office signed, the number of cremation permits issued and the overall number of calls received and handled by the Coroner's department.

While we have made "leaps and bounds" in how our department operates in recent years, I believe more could be done to better serve the residents

of Wood County. We have added a vehicle for Coroner use, County issued laptops for county business and, hopefully shortly, an office and body cooler. We have had a decedent locked in a private funeral home for well over a month. While they have been understanding and accommodating, I feel we should get their cooler back to them for their use and secure our own cases. This will come soon.

The Wood County Coroner's Office currently operates with all "on-call" staff. I believe Wood County needs to evaluate the current way the Coroner's office is staffed and operated to see if there is a better operational method to better serve the residents, businesses, health care agencies and other departments we work with daily.

In December, we had numerous death certificates that took longer than expected to sign. Generally, we strive to sign death certificates within 5 business days. However, December saw a change in what was needed to obtain medical records. In late December, HIPPA changed and required the use of an "attestation form" be submitted for every medical records request along with the standard medical records request. After the change went into effect, health care agencies developed their own attestation forms, and everyone was slightly different. We developed our own form on our letterhead, had it approved by Corporation Counsel and began using it. Thus far it has been well accepted, and medical records have again begun to come in. When there is a delay in signing a death certificate for any reason either myself or the appropriate Deputy Coroner reaches out to the family and funeral home explaining the reason for the delay.

<u>**#2 – Calls for Service:</u>** North end Wood County received a total of 72 calls for service, 5 of which were requests to scene deaths. South end Wood County received a total of 46 calls for service, 8 of which were requests to respond to scene deaths. I received a total of 6 calls requesting follow-up information or requesting copies of reports.</u>

<u>#11 – Other</u>: We handled one case that sadly the decedent suffered severe crushing injuries because of being entrapped by a machine while at work. We are currently working with OSHA in investigating this death

<u>#12 – Pending:</u> We have three current cases in "pending." One is a suspected overdose; one is a decedent found in a vacant field in Marshfield and the third is under investigation by law enforcement. Autopsies have been completed, and we are waiting for final toxicology to determine both manner and cause of death.

We received toxicology and/or autopsy reports back on three prior cases in "pending." We were able to clear up some prior cases and sadly, all were attributed to accidental and due to multiple drug toxicity.

#15 – Autopsies: In December we had two autopsies performed at UW Madison. One case is a deceased individual found in a vacant field in Marshfield and is currently under investigation. The second case is still ongoing and continues to be investigated by law enforcement.

TRAINING (MONTHLY) -

In the month of December Wood County K9 teams trained with Nekoosa PD and Wisconsin Rapids PD. Venues for training consisted of Wood County Range, Assumption High School, Ocean Spray Building, and Vesper Fire Department. The K-9 teams focused on odor detection, building clearing obedience, obedience around weapons, and apprehension obedience work.

TRAINING (INDIVIDUAL) -

- K9 Rosco and Deputy Beathard had individual training of obedience and narcotic work.
- Sergeant Arendt and K9 Timo had one hour of on duty training focusing on obedience and door popper exercises.
- Lieutenant Christianson and K9 Bingo completed 3.5 hours of training while at work. These trainings were in the area of odor detection and tracking.

USEAGE -

- K9 Rosco and Deputy Beathard had three deployments for the month of December. K9 Rosco had a school search at Assumption High School, A sniff at Mary's Place, and a search of a home residence. K9 Rosco did not have any CIB or indications at these locations.
- Lieutenant Christianson and K9 Bingo deployed to Green Bay and completed security at Lambeau Field for Packer game. Dozens of vehicles and bags were sniffed with no change of behavior or indication observed.

Security Services screened 6,616 people entering the courthouse for the month of December. Security Services had 35 security requests from different departments within the Courthouse. We also served two (2) civil process papers, assisted with two (2) jury trials, and fulfilled one (1) warrant for the month.

Security Services handled three (3) complaint in the jail. The complaints were for a Criminal Damage to Property complaint and two (2) battery to a Corrections Officer.

This month the County Board held a ribbon cutting/open house for the new entrance/Sheriff's Department/Jail project. This event brought in hundreds of people to not only show them the project but to inform them as well of the needs that this new facility is fulfilling for the county. From the feed back that I have heard, it was a positive event that went very well.

During the month of December, I utilized part-time employees for 38 hours to fill employee shortage hours. Several shifts ran short due to no part-time employees able to help.
